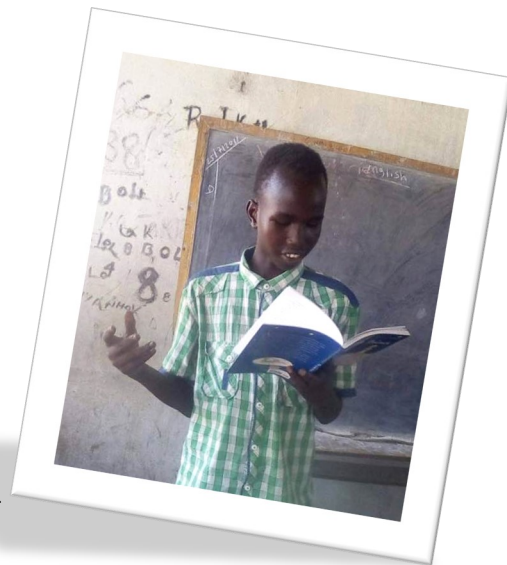
Made by Momma

The Story Circle Pro-

ject was brought to displaced street kids in in Gamballa, Ethiopia by a retired Calgary teacher, Vera Goodman to give students a chance at reading, writing and a better life.

"This boy learned English in Kenya. He revised a whole chapter of The Little Prince in Neur and now discusses it with the students. He has been assigned to coach five other students. The Project is being carried on in remarkable ways."



Soap for Hope Calgary

Soap for Hope is a charity under Disaster Aid Canada, and collects used soap, shampoo and other toiletries from hotels and the public, which would otherwise be thrown out. The personal care products are then repurposed into "hygiene kits" and donated to shelters and outreach programs. Along with local efforts, the charity also helps out internationally. Edgar and four other Soap For Hope representatives embarked on a humanitarian trip to Nepal in 2017, where they distributed 15 bins of aid material to communities recovering from a 2015 earthquake that devastated the country.
